The Power of Prayer

There is a line in the Tefillah of Neilah on Yom Kippur that says:

“היום יפנה השמש יבא ויפנה נבואה שעריך” “The day is coming to a close. The sun is about to set. Let us enter into your gates”.

Sometimes the first part of a typical day may be disappointing to us. A transaction that we had hoped for fell through, a job that we had applied for was denied, or we turned in a poor performance on a test for which we have studied. Such negative experiences may depress us so much that the rest of the day is a waste. We may have lost the energy or initiative to do anything.

The above line in the Tefillah of Neilah reminds us that if the first part of the day does not go as we wished, we should try to salvage the rest of the day. We should not allow ourselves to be pulled down by earlier losses, rather to make the rest of our day meaningful and constructive.
