The Power of Prayer

In the Selichos we recite the verse: “כרחם אב על בנים כן תרחם עלינו”

“As a father is merciful toward his children, so may You be merciful to us”.

As children of Hashem, we have the right to plead for mercy, just as we would expect a human father to be kind and compassionate with his errant child. Even if our actions deserve rebuke, we ask that the discipline should be tempered by paternal compassion.

But if we ask to be treated as children, we must relate to Hashem the way the Torah expects a child to relate to a parent, with respect and reverence. We cannot expect a parent child relationship to be one-directional.

During these days of Teshuva and introspection, as we recite the Tefilah of Avinu Malkeinu, we should give thought to the concept of reverence for our Father.
