## The Power of Prayer

In this column of "The Power of Prayer", rather than sharing an insight in or about tefilah, a few suggestions would be appropriate about how we can enhance our own personal power of prayer.

1. Choosing a specific tefilah to study and understand, will enhance our saying of it. Once we have a mastered our understanding of one tefilah, we can slowly focus on other tefilos and thus expand our appreciation of the tefilos we are saying.
2. Focusing better during times of tefilah. If we could remove external distractions, it would go a long way to enhancing our tefilos. One suggestion would be to turn off our smart phones for the very short period of time that we are davening.
3. Slowing down at least some of our tefilos, so we can have a better sense of what we have said.

These are three ideas that could help us enhance the power of our prayer.

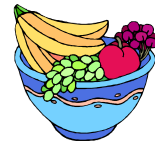
