Dear Member,

I would like to share with you an insight that I heard from the Rosh HaYeshiva of the Mir Yeshiva of Yerushalayim, Horav Chaim Shmulevitz, ZT"l. He shared this thought during the famous Entebbe hijacking in 1976 when he walked in to speak before they said Tehillim, praying for all the captives of that famous flight. He shared with his students the importance of everyone feeling as if they are davening for their mother or father, brother or sister, son or daughter. That is how everyone must feel as he davens for Acheinu Bnai Yisroel.

I share this thought with you now as the war in Gaza is over three months old and it is very easy to lose the intensity of feelings that we had in our Tefilos a few months ago. The war continues, precious lives are being lost, the hostages are still being held captive, and we must push ourselves to keep our Tefilos strong, and our hearts and minds focused on Acheinu Bnai Yisroel.

The Power of Prayer

The prayer of Adon Olam is one of the opening prayers in the morning, and some say it at the end of the evening service.

Adon Olam being the opening and closing prayer is similar to starting Sefer Bereishis on Simchas Torah immediately after finishing Sefer Devarim. It reminds us that the Torah is infinite; like a circle, it has no beginning or end. So it is with prayer, which represents our relationship with Hashem.
